


Figure 2. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current




Figure 3. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. **Collector Current**

Figure 4. Base Emitter Turn-On Voltage vs. **Collector Current**




Figure 5. Saturation Region






Figure 7. Output Capacitance


