



RATING AND CHARACTERISTIC CURVES (RS401L THRU RS407L)






FIG. 3- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




FIG. 4 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
